

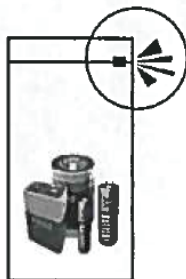

Instructions:

- 1** Place used or unwanted single-use, dry cell batteries inside your battery bag. Remember to cover 9V battery terminals with masking tape.
- 2** Seal the battery bag using the zip tab.
- 3** Place sealed battery bag on top of your curbside recycling box for collection during November ONLY. Condo or multi-units without curbside collection must put battery bags in the designated pail in your centralized collection area and ONLY during the month of November.
- 4** Batteries and bag will be recycled.

Single-use, dry cell alkaline batteries only:

The following single-use dry cell batteries are eligible for collection from the public: alkaline-manganese, zinc carbon, zinc air single-use batteries.
