



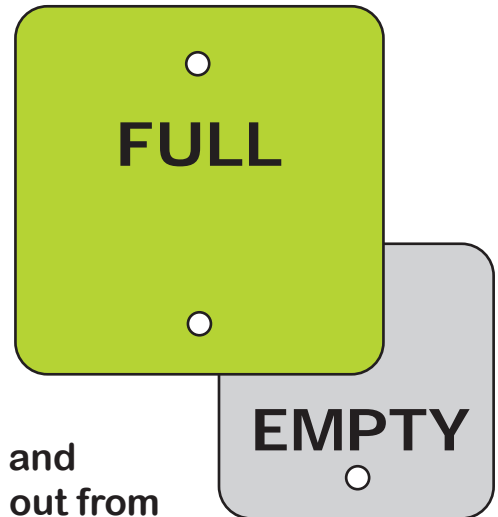
THE WASTE TAB

If you have a stationary curbside garbage box – you need to use The Waste TAB!

Install before July 1st, 2016

Using The Waste Tab will create a more efficient collection program and avoid missed collection.

Install The Waste Tab using a wood screw with a head 1/4 inch or smaller. This will ensure the Tab can be easily turned to either the full or empty side. Install the screw on an upward angle and leave 1-1/2 inches of unthreaded screw extended out from the side of your box. If you have a metal or plastic box use a wooden backer block to hold the screw in place. Ensure the placement of your Tab is visible by the collection staff from the street. Do not install the Tab on the top of the box, winter snow will obscure the Tab.



Once you have placed bagged garbage, bagged recyclables or (if it fits into your particular box) even your green bin in the box, turn the Tab to the “full”, green side. This will let the collector know you have items for removal. Once items are removed the collector will turn the Tab to “empty”.

Remember there is a garbage set-out limit: first bag is free, a second bag must be tagged with a Town garbage tag - a third bag is not allowed and will not be collected.

If you don't use The Waste Tab to indicate you have waste for removal from your stationary garbage box - your waste may not be collected! Be sure to have The Waste Tab installed before July 1st, 2016.

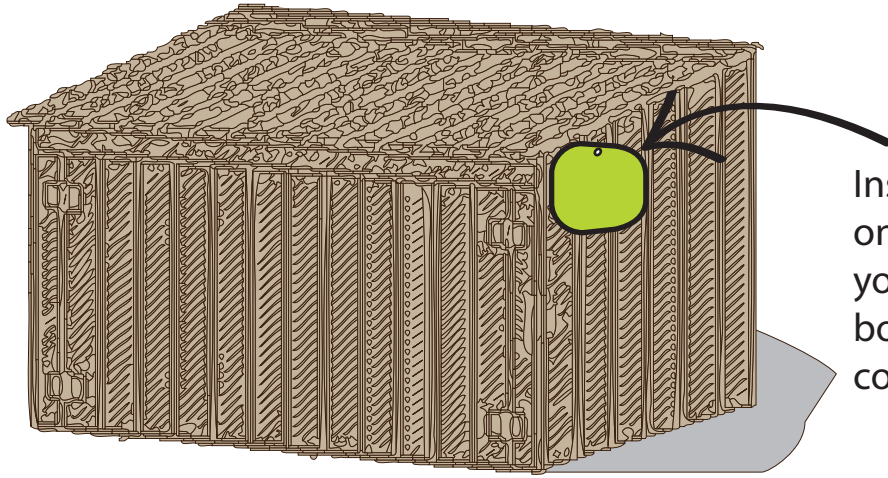

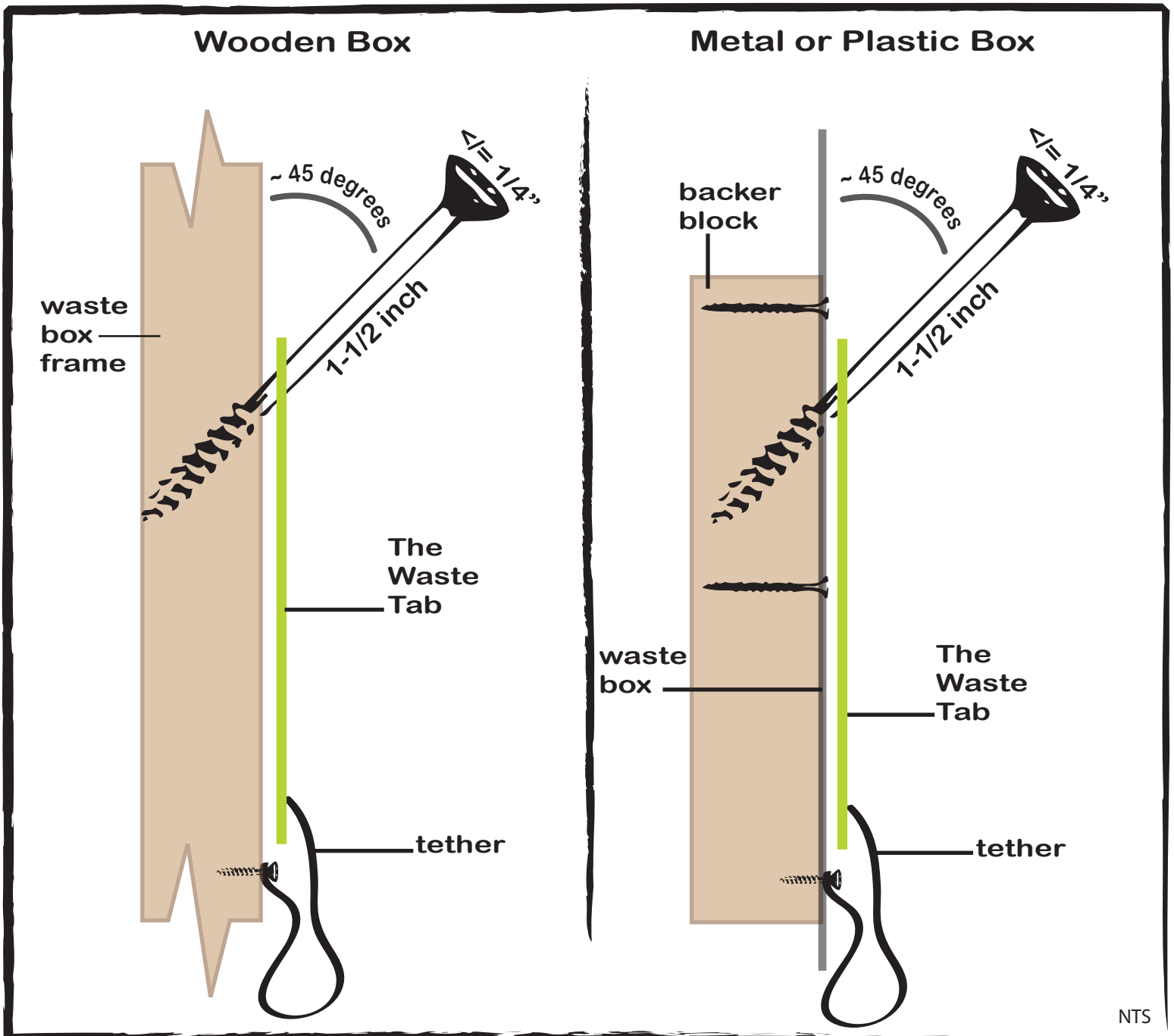
