Subject: Road load Restrictions - transportation of Drinking Water

To whom it may concern,

My name is Daniel Chretien and we have a house at [REDACTED] Blue Mountains / Clear-view towline rd and our only source of water comes from a cistern .

I was informed that the water company we use (Bay Mount Water Services) is being put on road load weight restrictions when transporting water for the period of 3 months

this is forcing Bay Mount to take many more trips which makes no sense to deliver the same amount of water or perhaps face penalties and fines ,

The need for drinking water is 365 days a year and these additional costs will force them to charge more for Water ,

How does this make sense as these extra trips will cause even more wear and tear on our roads ?

Although I understand the stress on the roads at this time of year needs to be limited some how the exemption of Water for human consumption should be considered.

We are asking that you please consider lifting this restriction for Bay Mount Water services so when we are in need of water we are not faced with these additional surcharges.

Again also please consider the impact of these extra trips on the roads as you should not expect people to use less water in their daily routines at certain times of year ,
