CONSIDERATION OF BY-LAWS TO ASSUME AND CLOSE AND STOP-UP AN OPENED ROAD ALLOWANCE

Please be advised that Council of the Town of The Blue Mountains will consider a by-law that if enacted, would assume and close and stop-up a portion of municipal highway allowance described as:

1. The southerly portion of Craigmore Crescent

This proposal is required to close a portion of the highway that connects Craigmore Crescent to Grey County Road 19. This intersection has poor road geometrics (grade) and reduced sightlines. The intersection does not meet the current Town road design standards. The Road segment is gravel and has not been upgraded to Town standards. Council will now hear public input on the proposal to close this highway section. The Town has no intentions of selling the said property at this time.
