Per your request, please forward this claim for reimbursement to the Council of the Town of Blue Mountain (TBM). My request seems simple enough. As the Council of the TBM is surely aware, as a condo owner at Mountain Springs Resort, I was required by the TBM to have an Electrical Safety Authority Inspection completed as part of the required Short Term Accommodation (STA) License process. This Inspection cost me \$136.73 (receipt provided to Mr. Luc Proulx). Shortly after I paid this expense, the TBM changed its mind and no longer required me to complete the STA, and thereby the Electrical Safety Authority Inspection. Because the TBM required me to assume this expense of the Inspection, then changed its mind by deciding to suspend the STA requirement (thereby made the Inspection unnecessary) it seems reasonable that I be reimbursed for the cost of the Electrical Safety Authority Inspection that I was unnecessarily required to pay.
