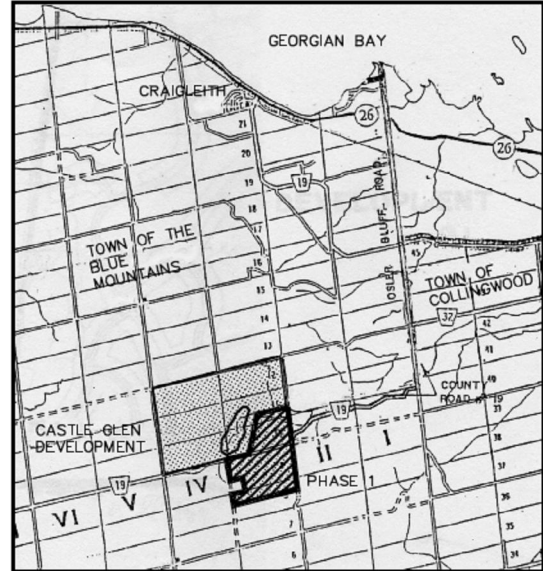


NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION OPEN HOUSE AND PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED

CASTLE GLEN DEVELOPMENT, TOWN OF THE BLUE MOUNTAINS INTERIM DRINKING WATER SUPPLY FOR PHASE 1 OF THE DEVELOPMENT CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY, PHASES 3 AND 4

Castle Glen Development is undertaking Phases 3 and 4 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment to determine the preferred interim water servicing design concepts for Phase 1 of the Castle Glen development. The interim water supply must have sufficient capacity to service the existing Thunderhill community and a 70 ha development area east and south of County Road 19, as specified in the Official Plan for the Castle Glen Resort Community and approved by the Ontario Municipal Board in October 2006.

The study is being carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for a 'Schedule C' project as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document.



A Public Information Open House is being held to provide an opportunity for the public to review and provide input on the water supply alternatives and on the water servicing design concepts under consideration. Representatives from the project engineering consultants will be present to answer questions.
