Dear Mayor Anderson;


Thank you for your October 18, 2013 e-response to our letter of September 26, 2013 and Mr. D. Finbow's e-response of the same day. Also, Mr. Finbow's October 22, 2013 e-response regarding our Noise Bylaw amendment request.

Members of our neighborhood have already contacted the Ontario Premier and MPP Wilson, as well as the media. At the time of this writing we are aware that 15 of the other property owners in our subdivision have also registered their concern to you and/or Mr. Finbow. Unfortunately we see no satisfaction in immediately dealing with our concerns, and your plan to write the Premier may come well after "the Horse is out of the barn" for stopping the monstrosity being inflicted on our community.

With all due respect, we believe it is the responsibility of our elected Council and officials to resolve issues with senior government. The property owners along west Timmons Road and Kimheather Court are requesting an immediate moratorium of all wind energy projects within established single family residential communities, including the above project in early stages of progress until:

1. The Province has resolved and vested the authorities it should give to the Municipality in such situations, and
2. The Town Planner has had sufficient time to investigate and report the facts behind whatever REA was submitted for the current project. **There was definitely no consultation with potentially affected home owners.**
3. The Town is fully satisfied that the construction of the subject wind turbine will be safe, considering the very unstable subsurface below the proposed erection site.
4. Noise pollution will be dealt with in the Noise Bylaw if the project is completed.
