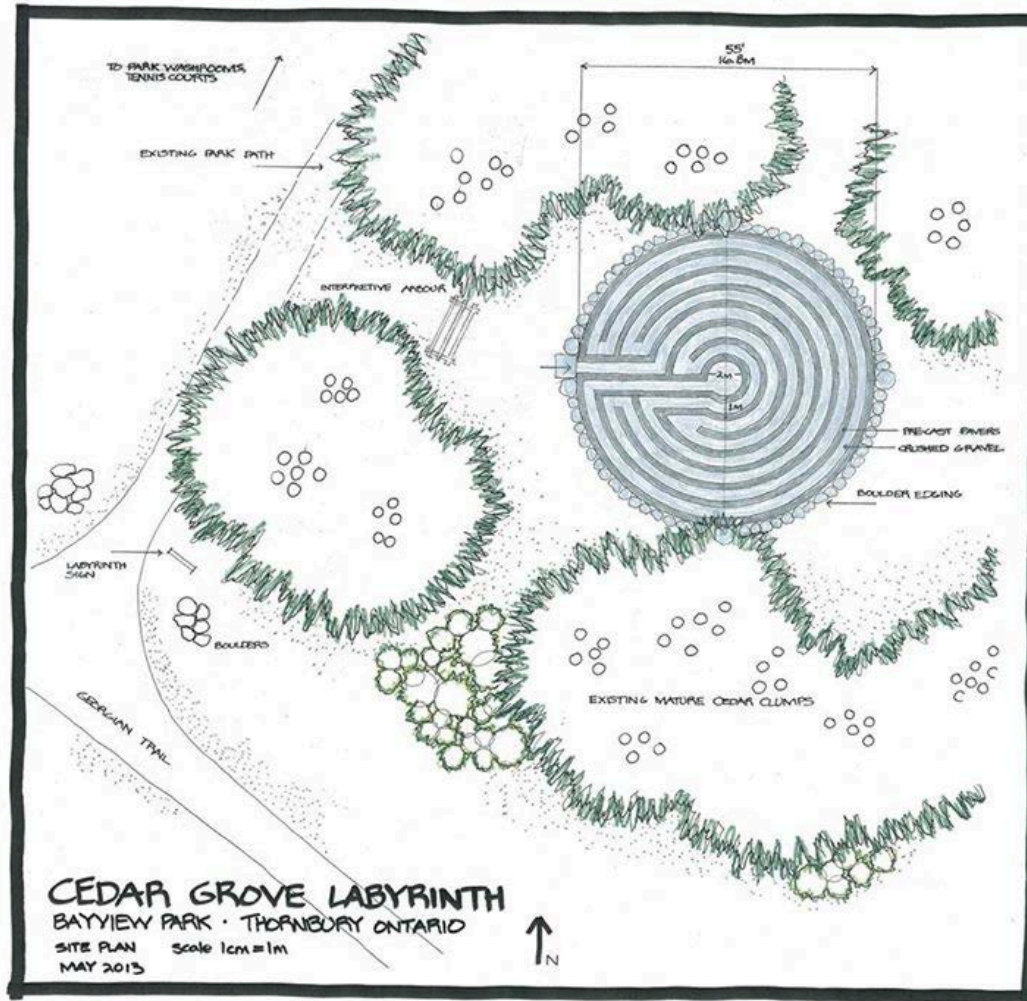
Phase II – Open air, accessible picnic structure

Phase II – Intention...

The Blue Mountains Women of 12 would like permission to access a 12 x 14 piece of land adjacent from the labyrinth in order to build an open air, accessible picnic structure. The intention of the build is to further encourage individuals, families and groups to spend time down at the labyrinth site not only to access the labyrinth; as well to further enjoy the park surroundings. It has been discussed with the Director of Parks and Recreation that an accessible picnic table will be installed through the Town once the structure is in place.
