**A. Recommendations**

**THAT** Council receive Report CSPW.15.21 entitled “Bicycle Friendly Community Signage”, for information purposes;

**AND THAT** Council direct Staff to purchase 10 bicycle friendly community silver designation signs to be placed at gateways into the Blue Mountains as well as at other key locations throughout the municipality.

**B. Background**

At the April 8, 2014 Committee of the Whole meeting, Staff was directed to provide a report to identify locations and cost to install bicycle friendly silver designation signs at gateways into the Blue Mountains to help promote this significant accomplishment.

Staff recommend that 10 signs be purchased and installed at the following locations:

**ROADWAYS**

1. Highway 26 – East Gateway
2. Highway 26 – West Gateway
3. Grey Road 2 – Kolapore Entrance
4. Grey Road 13 – Heathcote Entrance
5. Grey Road 19 – Osler Bluff Road Entrance
6. Grey Road 19 - 12<sup>th</sup> Side Road Entrance

**FACILITIES**

7. Craigleith Heritage Depot
8. The Blue Mountains Town Hall
9. Beaver Valley Community Centre
10. Hester Street Parkette

**C. The Blue Mountains’ Strategic Plan**

Supporting the development of social and recreational programs to meet the broad range of needs in the community

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**D. Environmental Impact**

Minimal environmental impact associated with the use of resources for the manufacture and installation of the additional signs.

**E. Budget Impact**

Staff is recommending a total of 10 signs be purchased. The cost per sign is \$65.00 which includes manufacture and delivery. Installation of the signs will be completed by Town Staff.

The total cost of purchasing 10 signs will be \$650.00.

Funding for the purchase of these signs is suggested to be sourced from the 2015 wayfinding Signage Project.
