A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report EPW.14.006, "Assumption By-law for Alpine Flatlands Subdivision Registered Plan 1126";

AND THAT Council enact a By-law to approve full acceptance and assumption of the public works constructed and installed within Registered Plan 1126, less Block 25.

B. Background

Staff have determined that all developer obligations have been met under the Subdivision Agreement for Registered Plan 1126, Alta Road, as shown on Attachment 1. Block 25 on Plan 1126 is specifically excluded from this assumption as Municipal Works constructed on this Block are associated with the Alpine Flatlands Phase 2/Alpine Springs subdivision works.

All Department Heads have acknowledged clearance of the acceptance and assumption of the Works.

All securities for these projects have been returned, there are no outstanding costs and it is appropriate that the Town assume the Works as Municipal Works.

A draft by-law has been prepared to initiate the following and is provided as Attachment 2.

1. All of the public works constructed and installed in accordance with the subdivision agreement for Registered Plan 1126 less Block 25 are hereby accepted and assumed.
2. Alta Road as shown on Registered Plan 1126 is hereby assumed for public use.

Staff recommends Council enact a By-law to approve full acceptance and assumption of the public works constructed and installed within Registered Plan 1126, Alta Road, less Block 25.
