Add to the mix, bicycles rolling downhill, or the zig zag of riding uphill. We have skate boarders - just having fun. We have small children learning to ride bicycles. We have our own local residents strolling down the centre of the road. This is the route to the beach.

The worst to witness was a young mother pushing a baby carriage on roller blades. She was completely out of control as she rolled down the hill.

What to do? I don't know, but we have to do something before we have a serious incident.

A few way stop at both King St W. and Huron St W. would be indicated. I doubt if bicycles are going to pay much attention.
