A. Recommendations

THAT Council receives Staff Report SRB.09.07 for information purposes.

B. Background

In February of 2007, By-law No. 2007-12 was passed by Council to regulate or prohibit the parking or leaving of a motor vehicle on privately-owned land without the consent of the owner of the land.

In October of 2008, By-law No. 2008-92 was passed by Council which designated certain individuals as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers to enforce 2007-12 along with other designate parking infractions (ie: fire route & disabled person parking) on GCC 24 (Cachet Crossing) and GCC 31 (Heritage Corners).

The following chart indicates the number of Parking Infraction Notices (PIN'S) issued at each of the above noted properties together with fines received/paid to date from these tickets.
