Background

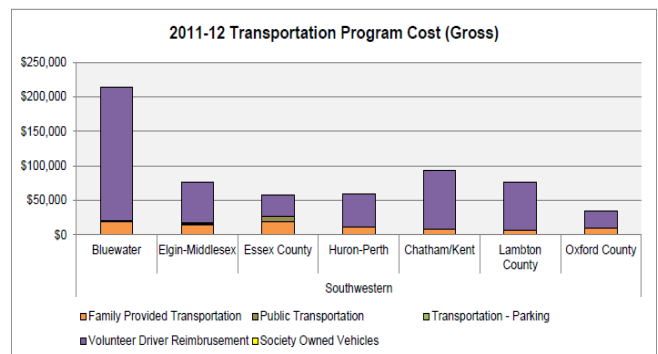
- 2005 was the first year for Sail for Hope
- ~100 guests pay \$75 each for an afternoon cruise on a sail or power boat, dinner under a tent at the harbour with their host boaters followed by entertainment and a silent auction
- TYC members donate their boats (26 host boats in 2012) and their time
- Almost 50 local businesses donate everything; restaurants donate food for meal, businesses donate items for silent auction, tent, music, give-aways...
- Volunteer Crew headed by Past Commodore of TYC as the chairman of the event, committee of 14 and an additional 'day of' volunteer crew of 20. Committee and crew made up of TYC members and CCS volunteers

Facts about Thornbury Yacht Club...

- Established 1983
- 125 members
- ~100 boats in Thornbury Harbour
- Social, Cruising, Education/Training and Racing Focused
- 70% of TYC members are property owners in TOBM

How Much Has Been Raised?

- In the 8 years this annual event has been running, it has raised more than \$100,000
- All monies go to local unit and used locally.
- The Blue Water Unit of the Canadian Cancer Society has one of the highest spend requirements of any unit in Southern Ontario in helping cancer sufferers get to major treatment centres.
- Most of the funds raised go to support transportation programs
