A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report DOR 10 40 Road Closure and Parking Lot Closures for the June 30th Clarksburg 150th Celebrations and July 1st Canada Day Parade and Festivities, and;

THAT, the deposit fee of \$2,500.00 as required in Section 2(o) and \$500.00 Permit fees as required in Schedule "A" of the By-law be waived for the 2010 events.

B. Background

At the April 12, 2010 meeting of Council the Clarksburg 150th on June 30th, and Canada Day Festivities on July 1, 2010 were designated a Significant Community Festival Event.

As a follow up to this report Staff is requesting that the Clarksburg Marsh Street Parking Lot be closed for the June 30th, 150th Sesquicentennial Event from 2 p.m. to 12 am July 1st, and that King Street from Landsdowne Street to Bruce Street North and Bruce Street North closed from King Street to Highway 26 from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m., and that the Hester Street Parking lot be closed from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m for the Pancake Breakfast, and that the Clarksburg Marsh Street Parking lot and Laneway be closed for the duration of the Canada Day Parade from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

To ensure that the requirements of the By-law No. 2005-34 "Being a By-law for Road Use permits for Events and to regulate the Temporary Closing of Highways" is adhered to, Town Staff is requesting that the deposit of \$2,500.00 as required in Section 2 (o) and \$500.00 Permit fees in Schedule "A" of the By-law be waived.

The Town has received approval from the County of Grey for the Temporary Closure of Grey Road 13 (Bruce and Marsh Street) from Highway 26 to Clark Street from 7:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

FOR INSURANCE COVERAGE OF THESE EVENTS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 204(1) OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT, THE **BIA** IS CONSIDERED "A LOCAL BOARD OF THE MUNICIPALITY FOR ALL PURPOSES" SO WILL BE COVERED UNDER THE TOWN'S INSURANCE AS INDICATED IN SECTION 279(1) OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT FOR THE CANADA DAY PARADE.

Float guidelines:

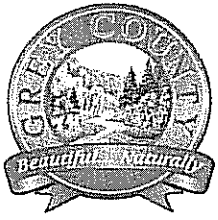
Children on floats must be sitting at all times
