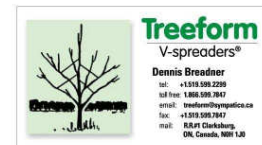
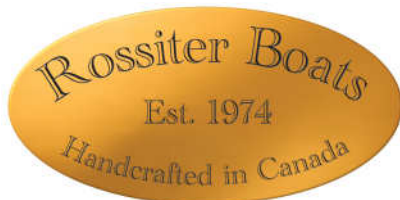

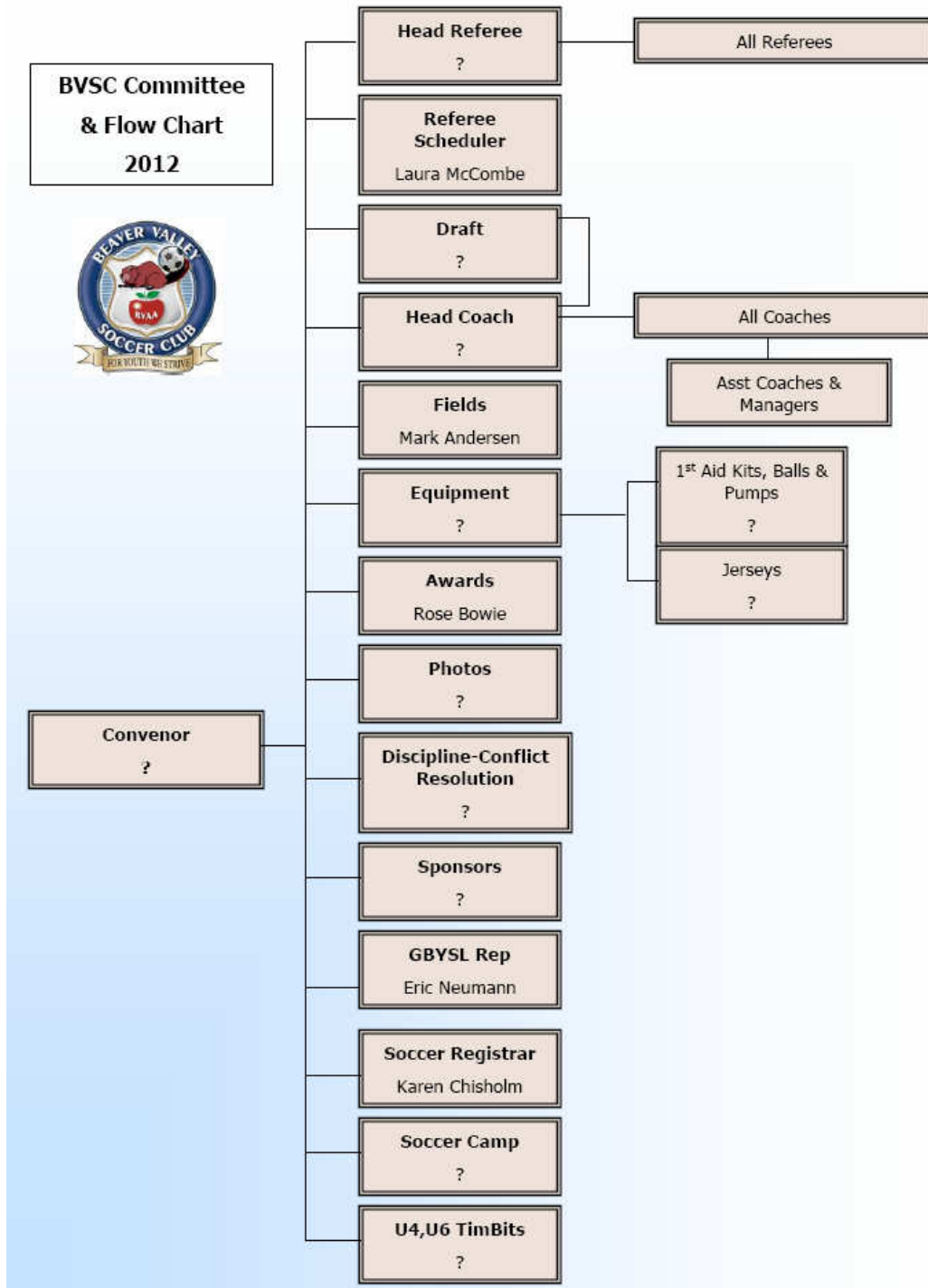
The BVAA AGM is in October to elect the new Soccer Convenor.
