**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING WITH REGARD TO AMENDING BY-LAW 2014-51,
BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH DEVELOPMENT CHARGES FOR THE TOWN OF

On Wednesday, September 3, 2014 the Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains will hold a Public Meeting regarding the amendment of By-law 2014-51, being a By-law to establish development charges for the Town of The Blue Mountains. The purpose of the proposed amendment is to clarify the residential charges applicable in the Camperdown Service Area for water and wastewater services. No other development charges under By-law 2014-51 are impacted by this proposed amendment.

Council is required in accordance with the Corporate Provision of Notice Policy, to hold at least one Public Meeting to provide the public the opportunity to review and comment on the amendment of By-law 2014-51. Information regarding the amendment of By-law 2014-51 will be available, with Town representatives in attendance to respond to inquiries and to receive comments from the public.
