## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING A NEW REGULATORY BY-LAW**

On Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains will hold a Public Meeting, regarding a proposed Sewer Discharge By-law. The proposed By-law will replace the former Township of Collingwood By-law 80-14 and the former Town of Thornbury By-law 22-1977 and would apply to the whole of the Town of The Blue Mountains.

Council is required in accordance with the Corporate Provision of Notice Policy, to hold at least one public meeting to allow the public the opportunity to review and provide comments on the proposed Sewer Discharge By-law.
