
RE: Chili Ribfest

**RE: Fees to Establish No Parking Signs
Regarding July 8, 9, 10/11 Chili Ribfest**

We understand that the Town of The Blue Mountains will be charging this event a fee of \$2,500.00 to establish temporary no parking signs on roads that are around the Cedar Run site. Although we appreciate the great assistance Council and your staff have given our event, we would respectfully request a 50% reduction in the established fee. This is based upon the Thornbury Clarksburg Rotary Club's participation in this event. We are partners with the Perrin Group based on a 50% ownership split.

As you are aware, the Thornbury Clarksburg Rotary Club is a non profit association and one of our major goals is to provide assistance to the Thornbury Clarksburg area community. We have designated any profits associated with this event will go to local community needs such as the new community health clinic.

C.10 Rotary Club

Re: Request for Reduction in Fees

Referred to Recreation &
Building and By-Law

Councillor Halos spoke regarding Agenda Item C.10 referencing the Rotary Club's request for a reduction in fees, noting the event is split 50/50 between the Rotary and a for-profit group. Joe noted Council should consider the request for a reduction in fees.

Acting CAO and Director of Engineering and Public Works Reg Russwurm spoke suggesting Council make a donation to the Rotary rather than waiving the fees, Joe concurring noting the cost to erect the signs would be borne by the Roads Department if the fees were waived.

Councillor McKean then spoke noting there are two events being held at Cedar Run this weekend and noted the Rotary should be refunded 25% of the \$2500 fee.

Councillor Gamble then spoke noting he did not support this at the Finance and Administration Committee meeting and noted this fee should be absorbed in further economic development.

Deputy Mayor McKinlay then spoke questioning if a portion of the \$2500 fee is to be paid to the County, Director of Recreation Shawn Everitt replying no, that The Blue Mountains' Staff will do all the work.

THAT Council of the Town of The Blue Mountains supports the Rotary Club of Thornbury & Clarksburg with a donation of \$625 and that the sponsorship will be funded from the Economic Development Initiatives Budget

In speaking to the Motion, Deputy Mayor McKinlay questioned if the Town can bill the other organizations involved with the Chili Ribfest for their portion of erecting the temporary no parking signs, Director of Recreation Shawn Everitt replying yes that the Town will bill the organizers as well as the organizers for the horse event.

Council then voted on the Motion, Carried.
