A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report DOR 10-46 "Location of 2010 Peak to Shore Festival" for their information;

AND THAT Council authorize and support the location for the "Peak to Shore Festival" as Louisa Street on the west side of Bruce Street for approximately 76 meters and the closure of this area for the duration of the event, Aug 21, 2010 to Aug 22, 2010.

B. Background

The Blue Mountains, Thornbury Business Improvement Area, The Blue Mountain Village Association and the Town of Collingwood have an agreement to host a multi location Music Festival, held from August 20, 2010 to August 22, 2010.

The festival will have 3 main music stages in each of the partners' locations. The Town of the Blue Mountains location is purposed to be on Louisa Street, from the west of Bruce Street for approximately 76 meters.

After discussions with Town staff, a change in location from the original purposed location was requested by staff due to bridge construction and the ability to enter and exit the Hester Street parking lot safely.

C. The Blue Mountains' Strategic Plan

This event fits well within the Mission Statement of the Town: "The Blue Mountains will be a progressive, four-season community, building on its agricultural and recreation features, offering a healthy and supportive lifestyle to a diverse range of residents, business and visitors."

The program also meets the Strategic Plan Objective: "Supporting the development of social and recreational programs to meet the broad range of needs in the community."

D. Environmental Impacts

This event will promote the area as a musical destination and will leave very little environmental impact.

E. Budget Impact

The only budget impact for this event, will be a total of \$200, to supply power to the event over the 2 days. The funding will allocated from the Events budget.
