## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION AND PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING A NEW REGULATORY BY-LAW AND CONTROL PROGRAM**

On Monday, May 27<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains will hold a Public Information Session and Public Meeting, regarding a proposed Backflow Prevention By-law and Control Program. The proposed By-law and Control Program will regulate cross connection and backflow prevention on plumbing systems as required to protect the Town of The Blue Mountains drinking water supply and distribution system from contamination.

Council is required in accordance with the Corporate Provision of Notice Policy, to hold at least one public information session and public meeting to allow the public the opportunity to review and provide comments on the proposed Backflow Prevention By-law and Control Program. Information and hand-outs regarding this Control Program will be available at the Public Information Session. Town representatives will be in attendance to respond to enquiries and to receive comments from the public.
