A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report SRB.10.30 respecting "Town Hall – Dedication Plaque" and provide direction with respect to their desire as it relates to the textual content of the Plaque.

B. Background

The New Town Hall Steering Committee has determined that a dedication plaque for the New Town Hall is appropriate. A wall located outside of the CAO/Clerk's/Mayor's Office has been identified for the display of the various plaques discretionary and required plaques to be displayed (Addendum A). Plaques that are required are related to Canada and Ontario's Financial Assistance through the Infrastructure Stimulus Fund and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities related to the committed Grant and Loan.

With respect to the dedication plaque, although not required, the Steering Committee are of the mind that it is appropriate. This dedication plaque could be as simple as containing the Town's Logo and a dedication along the lines of "This building is dedicated to the people of The Town of The Blue Mountains" or, as seen by the Steering Committee during our tours of other Town Halls, a dedication plaque that contains the names of Council and others.

Direction from Town Council is requested with respect to their desire as it relates to the textual content of a Dedication Plaque for the New Town Hall.
