Hi Ellen

As you know I have been interested & involved in the harbour for a number of years. I have helped with haulout in the fall & launch in the spring at the harbour almost every year since returning with our boat in 1979. This fall the water depth was the lowest I have ever seen, to the point that to haul some of the sailboats was difficult due to groundings of some of the deeper craft. They were unable to get themselves close enough to the dock to put the lifting straps on.

In a recent visit this week down to the harbour I noticed the level has receded approximately another foot since haulout. With this level some of the deeper draft sailboats that are stored in the shore for the winter will have great difficulty being launched in the spring. I am not sure if they will be able to be released from the crane straps far enough from the shore to be in deeper water or if the water will even be deep enough farther out?

Just an FYI for you and council.
