

That complaint has been ongoing for at least ten years without any effort on the part of anyone to correct the situation to which my complaint is directed.


When I last raised this with the Board of Directors it was discussed that some representative of the Board would attempt to meet with the municipality and I gather discuss the situation to which I have long referred and been concerned about.

As I suggested at the meeting I believe the installation of the sewer will not eliminate the problem. The septic system of the residences above me will continue to exist and the natural water flow through them will end up below and specifically at or under my place.

In the meantime I am taking steps now in an effort to direct this flow from my building and into the ditch. Not a good thing from everybody's point of view. However, nothing has been done by the condominium to deal with this situation.

I intend to recover my expenses. They are in process of being tallied and I will advise further.
