Terry reviewed the By-law Calls for the Months of April, May and June of 2017. Terry advised the Board there were 8 Unfounded Calls received in May, noting that by the time the police arrived the incidents had quieted down. Mayor John McKean questioned how

long it takes to respond to a call from the time the call is received, Terry responding that the response time is approximately 15 to 30 minutes.

Terry then reviewed the Quarterly Statistics of Violent, Property, Drug Crime, Unfounded, and Criminal Record Checks noting that all areas are still below in comparison to 2016 statistics.
