A. Recommendations

THAT Council receive Staff Report DOR.12.27 entitled “Beaver Valley Kinsmen Club Donation of a new replacement Dishwasher at the Beaver Valley Community Center” for information purposes;

AND THAT Council acknowledges and appreciates the donation of a new replacement dishwasher for the Beaver Valley Community Centre kitchen as offered by the Beaver Valley Kinsmen at no cost to the Town.

B. Background

Recreation staff has received a Letter of Intent from the Beaver Valley Kinsmen Club confirming the offering of up to \$10,000.00 for the replacement of the original dishwasher at the Beaver Valley Community Center kitchen.

The existing dishwasher is 26 years old and is the only remaining piece or original kitchen equipment. Originally, the kitchen had two dishwashers, however in 2010 one dishwasher was removed due to the increase of repairs required and the lack of available replacement parts.

The replacement dishwasher is commercial grade and has a very good efficiency rating and is recommended through this Report by staff.

This receipt of equipment through donation enhances the Beaver Valley Community Center kitchen facility at no cost to the Town through its strong partnership with the Beaver Valley Kinsmen Club.
