### **E.1 Swiss Meadows Contract (John Caswell will present a written report at the next meeting)**

E.2 Status of Ceiling Repair at Sewage Treatment Plant – John Caswell reported that discussion has taken place with CC Tatham and Maple Engineering regarding repairing the ceiling. Mr. Caswell will update the Committee as we progress to repair the damage.

E.3 Driveway concern - Gail Ardiel inquired what the status is regarding a driveway concern expressed by a resident that she had previously brought to the attention of this Committee. Paul Graham will follow up with a letter to the resident and will copy Councillor Ardiel.

E.4 The Town put an ad in the local newspapers with the dates that the Town would begin to pick up Christmas Trees; however, it was unclear if the Town would pick up the trees in rural areas. Paul Graham will follow up.

E.5 Bob Gamble forwarded a telephone message to Paul Graham to follow up with a resident requesting information regarding Town sewer and water installation.

E.6 Status of Parking Survey on Carmichael Crescent – Paul Graham confirmed that a report will be coming forth to the January 24<sup>th</sup> Engineering & Public Works Committee meeting.

E.7 Status of the 5-year road matters forecast – Paul Graham reported that we are working with the County of Grey regarding some of the projects contained in the forecasted report. E.8 Road Rationalization Study – Paul Graham assured the Committee that the County of Grey has confirmed that the Town will be involved in the process.

E.9 Road Counts for Craigleith Road – Don Hutchinson confirmed that there is road counts available as requested by a resident. The road is classified as a collector road and there is no parking on collector roads. Paul Graham will draft a letter for the Committee's approval at the next meeting.

E.10 Paul Graham mentioned to the Committee that there is an increasing problem with contractors using Town roads for the storage of materials and forms etc. We dealt with one contractor today, and Mr. Graham wanted Committee members to be aware of this.

E.11 The scheduling of meetings to deal with funding issues for local improvement type work—Paul Graham confirmed that there will be a report presented at the January 24<sup>th</sup> Committee meeting regarding Policy Statements – Guidelines for Sewer & Water Extensions.
