Property Location: 187 Arlberg Crescent

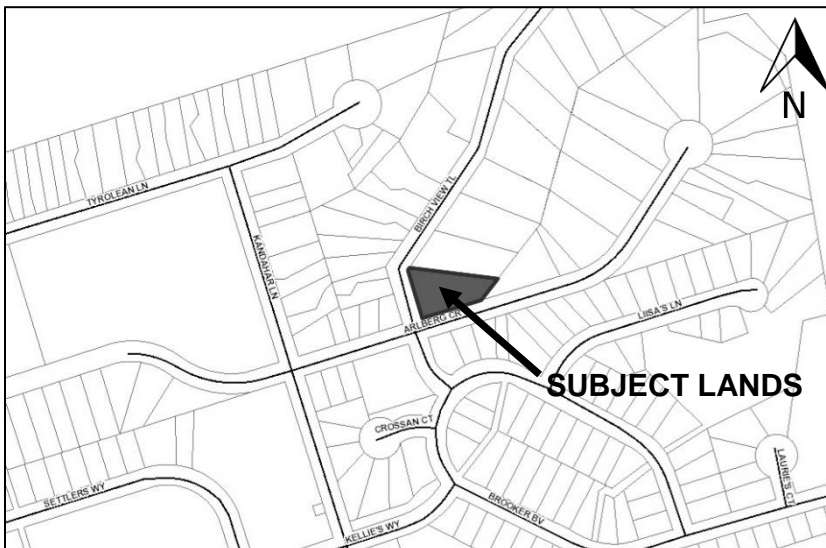

What is being proposed?

The applicant has applied to sever the property into two lots. If approved, this application will result in the creation of a new lot approximately 1,102m² in area, with approximately 19.8m of frontage onto Arlberg Crescent. The retained lands would be approximately 1,364m² in area, with approximately 44m of frontage onto Arlberg Crescent. Full municipal services are available along Arlberg Crescent.

The property is designated as Residential Recreational Area and Hazard in the Town of The Blue Mountains Official Plan.

The legal description of the property is Lot 14, Plan 824, Town of The Blue Mountains.



What happens at a Public Meeting?

The public meeting is your chance to hear more about the proposal and make your views about it known. You may also speak at the meeting or submit written comments. Information from the public will help Council in their decision-making process, so make sure to have your say!

Any person or agency may attend the Public Meeting and/or make verbal or written comments either in support or in opposition to the proposed amendment.

Your rights to appeal a decision:

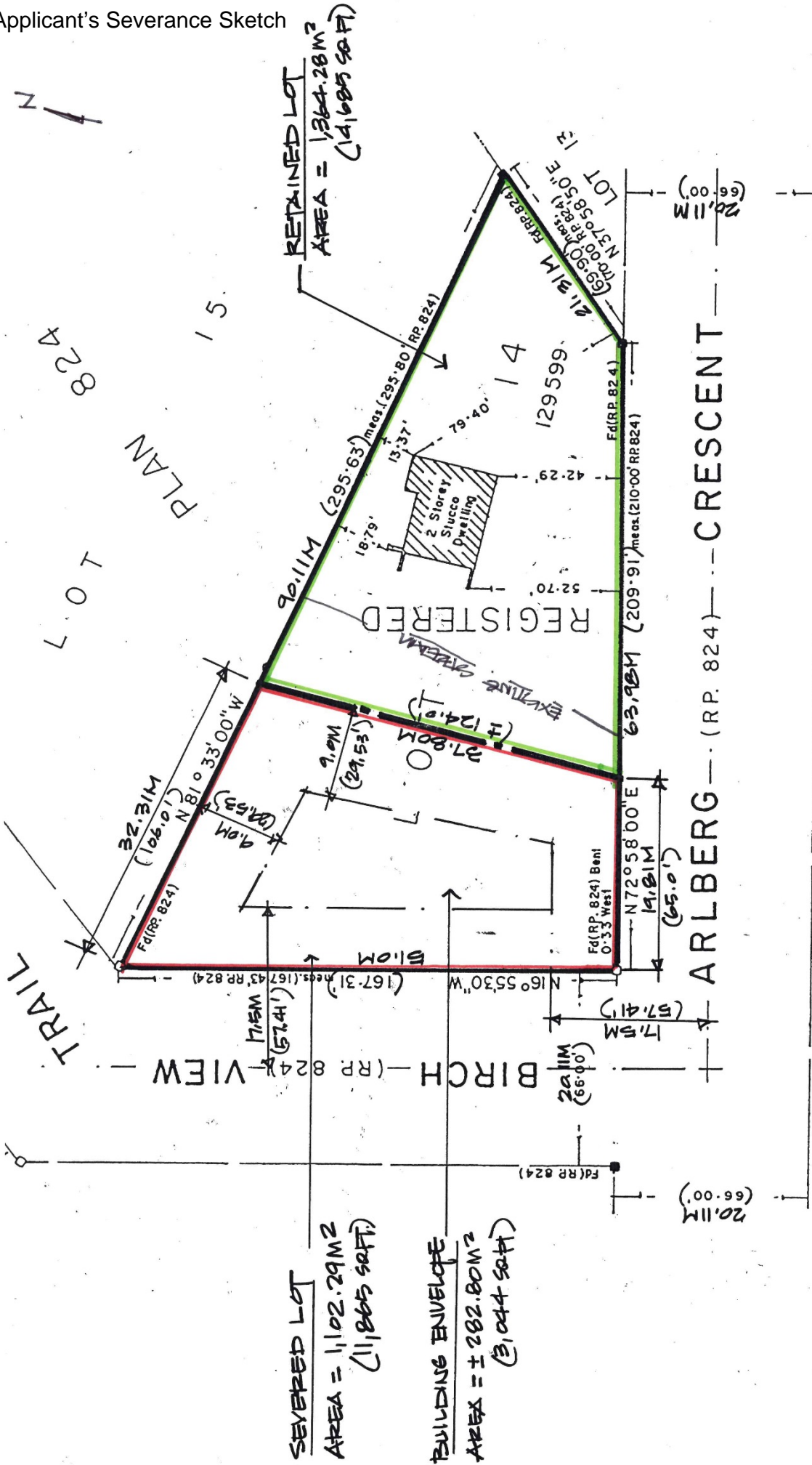
