The Town has initiated a comprehensive parking strategy study to review the policies and regulations applicable to parking within the municipality. J. D. Barnes Limited and Dillon Consulting Limited have been retained to undertake this work on behalf of the Town.

The Town, in conjunction with the consultants, is hosting two public information meetings on Saturday, February 3, 2007. A morning and an afternoon session are planned.

MORNING SESSION

The purpose of the morning session will be to gather input from the public regarding Town-wide parking issues with particular emphasis on: Thornbury, Clarksburg, trailhead areas, beaches, urban and rural parking issues, shared parking, on-street parking, cash-in-lieu policies and zoning by-law parking standards.

AFTERNOON SESSION

The purpose of the afternoon session will be to gather input from the public regarding parking issues specific to the Craighleith area and the Village at Blue. If you are primarily interested in parking issues in these locations please attend the afternoon session.
