## Removal of Point to Point Communication Equipment from the Thornbury Water Tower

### Fact Sheet

Why are we asking for Point to Point equipment to be removed?

- The TOBM is moving forward with the placement of communication equipment on the Thornbury water tower. As a result, the frequencies and broadband that The TOBM will be employing may affect the existing equipment that Point to Point is currently utilizing on the Thornbury water tower
- As well, Point to Point had no agreement with The TOBM to have equipment on the Thornbury water tower

How does this impact Grey County Communications?

- We are removing Grey County equipment from the tower, however the TOBM will provide Grey County with communication services by way of a new agreement. Please note, The Town will own the communications equipment moving forward

How does this impact local customers?

- The Town was told by Point to Point that they have about 20 customers served by equipment on the tower
- Initially Point to Point was asked that any and all communication equipment that is owned or operated by Point to Point Communications be removed from the Thornbury water tower before August 31, 2012
- Point to Point has requested a two month extension until the end of October, claiming that they can service half of the affected customers from another source. The Town has said they will allow that if Point to Point recognizes that the new Town equipment placed on the tower may affect their signal.

Customers who have contacted the Town by email have received links, sent by the Town and provided by Grey County, to identify other communication servers in this area
