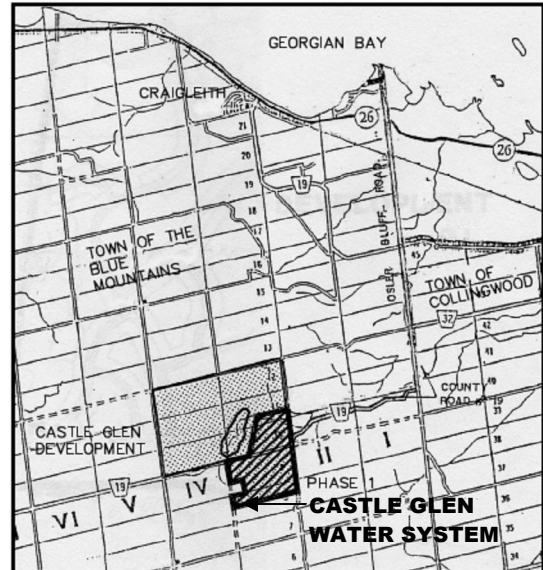


NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT

CASTLE GLEN DEVELOPMENT, TOWN OF THE BLUE MOUNTAINS DRINKING WATER SUPPLY FOR PHASE 1 OF THE DEVELOPMENT CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY, PHASES 3 AND 4

Castle Glen Development has undertaken Phases 3 and 4 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment to determine the preferred water servicing design concept for Phase 1 of the Castle Glen development.

It is proposed to establish for Phase 1 a new Castle Glen groundwater supply system. The drinking water system will be located south of County Road 19 at 3rd Line, and will consist of a pump house with filtration, disinfection and pumping equipment and a ground-level treated water reservoir. For Phase 2 of the development, a connection to the municipal Georgian Bay-based water system will be established and will include an expansion of the Mountain Road pumping station, a new booster pumping station at Osler Bluff Road and County Road 19, high pressure watermains to Castle Glen, and an expansion of the Castle Glen water reservoir. The groundwater system will be maintained to supplement the Georgian Bay water system.



The study has been carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for a 'Schedule C' project as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document. The Environmental Study Report has been completed and is available for review on the Town of the Blue Mountains website (thebluemountains.ca) and at the following location:

If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussion with the Town and Castle Glen Development, a person may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order) which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below by January 20, 2012. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Town Clerk. If no request for a Part II Order is received by the above date, the new Castle Glen water system will proceed to design and construction as outlined in the Environmental Study Report.
