Notice- Closure of Town Facilities Extended Until May 25, 2020

The Town of The Blue Mountains would like to advise residents that the closure of municipal facilities has been extended until Monday, May 25, 2020 to ensure and encourage physical distancing. Facility closures include: Town Hall, Beaver Valley Community Centre, Craigleith Community Centre, Ravenna Hall, and The Blue Mountains Public Library. In addition, the Craigleith Heritage Depot continues to remain closed.

In addition, the Town would like to remind residents that an interactive map confirming the open/closed status of parks, trails, greenspaces and recreational areas within the Town of The Blue Mountains is available on the Town website: www.thebluemountains.ca/covid-19-open-and-closed.cfm. The Town is also in the process of reopening Lions Park and Riverwalk to walkthrough/passage starting on May 5, 2020.
