Notice- COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on Saturday April 10th at the Beaver Valley Community Centre

A COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic will be held at the Beaver Valley Community Centre (BVCC) on Saturday, April 10th for those who are over 65, or will be turning 65 this year (ie. born in 1956 or earlier) and have not yet been vaccinated. Capacity this week is limited to 280 people and most spots have been filled by patients from local physicians and other lists.
