The Town of The Blue Mountains will be using internet and telephone voting for the 2018 Municipal and School Board Elections.

Help Centre – Extended Town Hall Hours

Do you need to check if you're on the Voters' List?

In addition to extended hours during the voting period noted below, a Help Centre will be available at Town Hall, 32 Mill Street. Elections Staff will be available to assist individuals wishing to confirm if they are on the Voters' List during normal hours of operation and the extended hours noted below.

Saturday, October 6	9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

As of **September 7, 2018** individuals may also check if they are on the Voters' List by visiting www.thebluemountains.ca/election.cfm.

On the Elections Page, enter the following information to check if you are on the Voters' List:

- First and last name;
- Date of Birth;
- Street address.

Qualifying individuals who **are not** on the Voters' List must fill out an [EL15 – Application to Amend Voters' List](#), and provide identification confirming their qualifying address. This information must be provided **in person** to the Clerk's Office.

You qualify to vote if:

- You are at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- You are a Canadian Citizen;
- You or your spouse lives, rents or owns property in the municipality; and
- You are not otherwise prohibited from voting.

Require assistance to vote?

Those individuals who require assistance to vote may attend the following Voter Help Centres during extended hours noted below (in addition to normal hours of operation) throughout the Voting Period (October 12 at 10:00 a.m. to October 22 at 8:00 p.m.):

The Blue Mountains Public Library, 173 Bruce Street South, will also be available during normal hours of operation throughout the Voting Period for those requiring assistance to vote.

Normal Hours: Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays - 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Tuesdays and Thursdays – 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Sundays – 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Electors requiring assistance to vote must bring their Voter Information Letter in order to allow them to access the internet or telephone voting system.
