Dear Ms. Giles,

We are unable to attend the Council meeting on June 25th but would like to record our views on the submission from Skelton Brumwell . Our private property abuts the town property on the west end adjacent to Lot 1. We have attended most of the meetings concerning the waterfront to keep ourselves abreast of this critically important situation. As Skelton Brumwell suggests, this is not just an important piece of land for the Town but it is of National concern. The ANSI designation requires all of us to be diligent in our protection of these lands from further abuse. Nature will indeed take its course as in the past, but preservation against human abuse going forward is everyone's concern. On Monday of this week, we had two men on our private property using chisels to remove rocks and fossils causing irreparable damage.

To this end, we support Option 3 of Skelton Brumwell's report which appears to be the best in supporting access, which the Town feels is important, and protection. Further to this, the signage and fencing that they suggest, is paramount to controlling the access to and future protection of this fragile area. We appreciate all that Council and staff have done in considering the best options for these lands and look forward to a resolution.
