I am a concerned citizen, living on Thornbury's [REDACTED]. Our road is travelled, non-stop, by huge construction vehicles transporting mammoth loads to facilitate building in the Lora Bay development. The speed limit is posted as 50 km/hour. It is very often not adhered to. Even if adhered to, it is way too fast when combined with pedestrians, cyclists, children, homeowner driveways, no sidewalks, gravel road, and a significant hill. The same situation is happening on Sunset Drive and Christie Beach Road. All are accidents-waiting-to-happen. They will be catastrophic.

I respectfully ask that the posted speed limit be reduced to 35 km/hr. This is a residential neighbourhood being travelled as a thoroughfare for heavy vehicles. The traffic needs to be calmed asap.

As I write this message, there has been a non-stop entourage of dump trucks, since 7:00 this morning, up and down the 39th Sideroad. There must be more foundations being excavated. So, yes, please provide the Transportation Committee with my concerns.

As an addendum to my first message, note that many beach goers are parking and walking on Sunset Blvd and Christie Beach Road. It's rather maze-like to manoeuvre. Speed and traffic with this activity is not a good combination!

Further addendum: I noticed video recording equipment was set up, for traffic study purposes, on Christie Beach Road at both the Highway 26 and 39th Sideroad intersections. It was installed on/about Thursday, July 23; removed on Monday, July 27. (I don't know at whose direction, which municipality, or for what purpose.) For whatever reason, there was a lull in construction traffic on that Thursday and Friday. And the construction traffic definitely lulls over weekend days. So from my perspective, that study's timeframe was not representative of the traffic volume, type, or speed that is happening here regularly.

Thank you for relaying my concerns. I look forward to a response after consideration has been given by the Committee.
