BY-LAW NO. 2001 - 88

As amended by By-Law Nos. 2003-05, 2003-06, 2003-49, 2003-100, 2003-119, 2004-26, 2005-11, 2006-12, 2007-107, 2008-83, 2008-118, 2008-119

OFFICE CONSOLIDATION

BEING a By-law to establish Fire Routes within the Town of The Blue Mountains.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 210, p. 52 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.O. 1990, the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law establishing fire routes within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of The Town of The Blue Mountains deems it necessary and expedient to establish such fire routes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of The Town of The Blue Mountains ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. SHORT TITLE

(A) This By-law may be cited as the Fire Routes By-law.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1 FIRE ROUTE the private property or part thereof designated as a fire route in accordance with the provisions of this By-law.
- 2.2 FIRE ROUTE SIGN means a permanently installed legible sign.
- 2.3 OWNER (when used in relation to a property) means:
 - a) the person, persons or corporation having an interest in the property or part thereof on which a private roadway has been designated as a fire route; or,
 - b) the tenant of the property or part thereof on which a private roadway has been designated as a fire route.
- 2.4 PRIVATE PROPERTY means property owned or occupied by a person or persons other than the Corporation of The Town of The Blue Mountains, or any local board thereof, and includes property owned or occupied by a corporation.
- 2.5 TOWN means the Town of The Blue Mountains.
- 2.6 VEHICLE means any automobile, motorcycle or other vehicle propelled or driven otherwise than by muscular power.

3. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 3.1 DESIGN STANDARDS FOR FIRE ROUTES shall be as provided in the Ontario Building Code, as amended.
- 3.2 LOCATION OF FIRE ROUTE shall be as provided in the Ontario Building Code, as amended.
- 3.3 DESIGNATION OF FIRE ROUTE the private property or portion thereof described in Schedule "A" forming part of this By-law is hereby designated as a fire route.
- 3.4 NOTICE TO OWNER/DESIGNATION OF A FIRE ROUTE upon the Town designating a private roadway as a fire route in accordance with this By-law, the Town shall notify the owner by prepaid mail or personal service as to those portions of the property which have been designated as fire routes.
- 3.5 ERECTION OF FIRE ROUTE SIGNAGE the owner shall erect fire route signs as described in this By-law within thirty days of the notice referred to in Section 3.4.
- 3.6 MAINTENANCE OF FIRE ROUTE the owner upon which a private roadway that has been designated as a fire route by this By-law shall:
 - a) maintain the signs marking it as a fire route; and,
 - b) keep such private road in good repair, clear of ice and snow and free of all obstructions including, but not limited to, vehicles, goods, wares, merchandise, articles or things.
- 3.7. VEHICLES PARKING/STANDING ON FIRE ROUTE PROHIBITED no person shall park or leave standing a vehicle on any fire route designated as such by this

By-law.

- 3.8 CONTRAVENTION LIABILITY/EXCEPTION OF VEHICLE OWNER the owner(s) of a motor vehicle parked or left standing on any fire route on private property designated as such in this By-law, is liable, as is the driver of such motor vehicle, to any penalty provided for in this By-law unless, at the time of the offence, the motor vehicle was in the possession of a person other than the owner(s) or his/her chauffeur without the owner=s consent.
- 3.9 AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE PARKING VIOLATION TAGS a peace officer or constable or an officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act* or an officer appointed for the enforcement of municipal by-laws may issue and attach to a motor vehicle found parking in contravention of this by-law a Town of The Blue Mountains parking violation tag alleging that the provisions of this by-law have been contravened.
- 3.10 AUTHORIZED REMOVAL OF VEHICLES IN CONTRAVENTION a peace officer or a constable or an officer appointed for the carrying out of the provisions of the *Highway Traffic Act* or an officer appointed for the enforcement of municipal by-laws may, upon discovery of a motor vehicle parked or left contrary to Section 3.8 of this By-law, cause such vehicle to be moved from such fire route and taken to and placed in a suitable storage place, and all costs and charges for removing, care and storage thereof, if any, shall be a lien upon the vehicle.

4. FIRE ROUTE SIGNS

- 4.1 MINIMUM SIZE OF SIGN 30 centimetres (12 inches) x 45 centimetres (18 inches).
- 4.2 MOUNTING HEIGHT minimum 2.0 metres measured from the top limit of the fire route sign to grade of the fire route surface adjacent to the fire route sign.
- 4.3 LOCATION OF FIRE ROUTE SIGNS fire route signs shall be erected so as to be visible at all times along the fire route, be spaced a maximum distance of 60.0 metres apart, and be visible to the traffic approaching. (By-law No. 2005-11)
- 4.4 SETBACK FROM FIRE ROUTE
 - a) where a curb or equivalent edge treatment is not provided to define the edge of the fire route, a minimum of 3.0 metres to any part of the sign; or,
 - b) where a curb or equivalent edge treatment is provided to define the edge of the fire route, a minimum of 0.3 metres and a maximum of 2.0 metres to any part of such sign. (By-law No. 2003-49)

(Note: Section 4.5 deleted Bylaw No. 2006-12 and subsequent Sections renumbered)

- 4.5 VISIBILITY the property owner is responsible to ensure that physical obstructions are not placed or constructed in locations that interfere with the visibility and/or legibility of any fire route sign and to ensure sufficient maintenance of vegetation such that unobstructed views to all fire route signs are maintained at all times and under all circumstances
- 4.7 SIGN POST TYPE AND MATERIAL shall be as described in Schedule "B" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
- 4.8 SIGN TYPE AND MATERIAL shall be as described in Schedule "C" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
- 4.9 Notwithstanding Section 4.3 of this By-law, the signage required in conjunction with those fire routes so designated within the lands known as the Village at Blue Mountain, Parts 1-40, 16R-7451, may be erected at the controlled vehicular entry points to the Village. (By-law No. 2005-11)
- 4.10 Notwithstanding Section 4.3 of this By-law, the signage required in conjunction with those fire routes so designated within the lands known as "Blue Mountain Resorts, Apple Bowl/Badlands Parking Lot and access to private dwellings" (Private drive/road extending north from Anne Heggveit Drive) may be erected at the west side of the intersection of Anne Heggveit Drive and the private road provided such sign incorporates the following:
 - (a) "No Parking" symbol minimum 600 mm in diameter; and,
 - (b) "By-law No. 2001-88" and "Tow Away Zone" ,minimum 100 mm in height.

And further provided such sign is erected at a height such that it is visible at all times and is a minimum of 1.2 m in width and 1.8 m in height.

Such sign may also contain additional wording so as to advise of the extent of the Fire Route and contain wording provisions provided such additional wording is approved by the Director, Building & By-law for the Town. (By-law No. 2008-119)

ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT

- 5.1 This By-law shall apply to all lands indicated in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
- 5.2 Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction, is liable to a penalty as provided in the *Provincial Offences Act*.
