WHEN DO I NEED A DECK PERMIT?

- 1) A building permit is **NOT** required in the following instances:
 - i. The proposed deck is less than 24" above finished ground level;
 - ii. Installing a guard(s) on a deck that is less than 24" above finished ground level;
 - iii. The extension or alteration of a deck that is less than 24" above finished ground level; or
 - iv. The replacement of only the deck boards on any deck structure.
- 2) A building permit **IS** required in the following instances:
 - a) The proposed deck is 24" or greater above finished grade
 - b) The replacement of existing guards on a deck described in a) above;
 - c) The replacement, extension or structural alteration of the deck described in a) above;
 - d) The proposed deck supports or will support roof loading regardless of size or height above grade.
 - e) A change of use to that other than residential purposes.

In all instances whether a building permit is required or not; conformity with the applicable Zoning By-law is required.

Design Requirements

- A homeowner designing a deck that requires a building permit is exempt from the designer qualifications (BCIN not required) and may design their own deck provided sufficient information has been provided in accordance with Building Permits By-law 2011-45. The homeowner (or authorized agent) shall provide a complete application including form "Schedule 1" for the proposed deck.
- 2. A qualified designer with a BCIN is required where a non-homeowner is designing the residential deck.
- 3. A residential deck greater than 24" above grade <u>and</u> supporting a hot tub shall be reviewed for structural adequacy by a qualified person.

In all instances whether a building permit is required or not; conformity with the applicable Zoning By-law is required.

Definitions

<u>Building</u>: "means a structure occupying an area greater than ten square metres (107ft²) consisting of a wall, roof and floor or any combination of them or a structural system serving the function thereof including all plumbing, works, fixtures and service systems appurtenant thereto." [Refer to BCA 1.(1)].

<u>BCIN</u>: Building Code Identification Number as required under section 3.2, Div. C of the Ontario Building Code.
