The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains

By-Law Number 2021-46

Being a By-law to amend By-law 2003-11, as amended, being a By-law to regulate the placing, standing, stopping or parking of an object or vehicle on highways within the Town of The Blue Mountains

Whereas Section 11 and Part III of the Municipal Act, 2001, and amendments thereto, enables the council of a local municipality to pass by-laws respecting the placing, standing, stopping or parking of an object or vehicle on highways;

And Whereas Section 42 of the Municipal Act, 2001, and amendments thereto, enables the council of a local municipality to pass a by-law to delegate to an employee of the municipality the ability to temporarily close a highway for any purpose specified in the by-law;

And Whereas Council of the Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains deems it appropriate to amend Bylaw 2003-11, as amended

NOW THEREFORE Council of The Corporation of The Town of The Blue Mountains hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 2003-11, as amended, is amended by repealing and replacing the preamble of Schedule "E" with the following new preamble to Schedule "E":

Schedule "E"

When authorized signs have been erected, the highways as set out in Schedule "E" shall be deemed no parking, no standing and no stopping areas between May 31, 2021 and October 29, 2021.

2. That By-law 2003-11, as amended, is amended by repealing and replacing the preamble of Schedule "F" with the following new preamble to Schedule "F":

Schedule "F"

When authorized signs have been erected, the highways as set out in Schedule "F" shall be limited parking and no person shall park a vehicle on the highway for more than the time limit posted thereon between May 31, 2021 and October 29, 2021.

And further that this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the enactment thereof. Enacted and passed this // day of June, 2021
