Local Media Review

The local media review project is underway and Town staff have started to identify local media providers. Over the coming weeks, Town staff will be contacting each provider. A staff report will be provided to the committee with options for consideration.

Communications Survey

- The revisions have been made to include the recommend changes to the survey. The survey will be launching near the end of March. The survey will run for five weeks through the Town's online public engagement platform 'Your View'. Paper copies of the survey will also be made available through Town Hall and the L.E. Shore Memorial Library.

Communications Strategy Timeline

 - o Final report presented to Communications Committee and Council
