NOTICE OF DECISION AND RIGHT TO APPEAL

Planning Act, RSO 1990 CHAP. P.13, Sec. 53 (19)(20), as amended

TAKE NOTICE that the enclosed is a certified copy of the decision of the Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains in the matter of an application pursuant to the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13.

THE DECISION OF THE COUNCIL MAY BE APPEALED to the Ontario Municipal Board by serving personally on, or sending by registered mail, to the **CLERK** of the Town of The Blue Mountains a prescribed **Appellant Form** setting out the objection to the decision and the reasons in support of the objection accompanied by a **CERTIFIED CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER**, made payable to the Minister of Finance, of the fee prescribed by the Ontario Municipal Board under the Ontario Municipal Board Act as payable on an appeal from Council to the Board.

Only individuals, corporations and public bodies may appeal decisions in respect of applications for consent to the Ontario Municipal Board. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or group on its behalf.

THE APPEAL MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CLERK OF TOWN OF THE BLUE MOUNTAINS BY 4:30 PM ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2011.

AMOUNT OF FEE payable on appeal is \$125.00, made payable to the Minister of Finance. Each related Consent appeal is \$25.00.

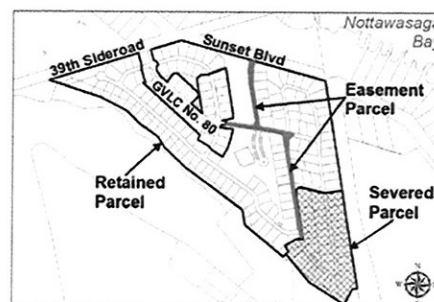
ON AN APPEAL to the Ontario Municipal Board, except where all appeals are withdrawn, a hearing will be held of which notice will be given to the applicant, the appellant, the Clerk, and to such other persons and in such manner as the Ontario Municipal Board may determine.

IF NO NOTICE OF APPEAL IS GIVEN within twenty days, the decision of the Council is final and binding, and the Clerk is required to notify the applicant.
