All application forms, drawings, and related documents shall be submitted electronically in PDF format to build@thebluemountains.ca or by using our secure ShareFile system. Please refer to our Electronic Submission Requirements Document

Application Forms

- 1. Private Pool Permit Application Form
- 2. Owner's Authorization Form (Required if Applicant is not the Owner)
- 3. Memorandum of Understanding and Indemnity for the Installation of Private Pools

Required Drawings and Specifications (All Drawings to be Black & White)

- 4. Site Plan and/or Lot Grading Plan
 - Site-specific Grading Plan designed & stamped by Professional Engineer or Ontario Land Surveyor required for all applications.
 - Site Plan must include all details of fence construction, indicate all setbacks from the proposed fence to the property lines & pool's edge, full details of all entrances and location of all proposed pool equipment

Fees Charges & Deposits

5. Private Pool Permit Fee \$100.00

Approvals from other Agencies are required in many instances before a pool permit application can be processed and before a permit is issued for pool construction. These approvals are not administered by Building Services. Please ensure all other required approvals are complete.

<u>Applicable Law</u>

Notes:

- A Temporary Fence is required to be in place during all phases of construction.
- Inspection of a pool enclosure is required prior to filling the pool with water.

Next Steps

Submit complete application including supporting documentation, electronically to build@thebluemountains.ca. Application is reviewed for completeness and compliance with the zoning bylaw and other Applicable Law. Town Inspector attends site to review proposed grading, pool & fence location. Permit will be issued when review is complete, and fees are paid. Town Inspector completes 2 inspections (initial & final) Once final inspection is completed and passed; the permit file is closed.
