By-Law Number 2022 – 50

Being a By-law to amend the Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law

Whereas The Town of the Blue Mountains has a system of Administrative Monetary Penalties which is administered in accordance with By-law 2021-71 (the “by-law”)

And Whereas sections 102.1 and 434 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, and O.Reg 333/07 provides that a municipality may require a person to pay an Administrative Monetary Penalty if the municipality is satisfied that the person has failed to comply with a by-law of the municipality passed under the Municipal Act;

And Whereas the Town of the Blue Mountains deems it appropriate to designate the Parking By-law for the purposes of the Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law 2021-71

Now Therefore Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains hereby enacts as follows:

That By-law 2021-71, being the Administrative Monetary Penalties By-law is hereby amended as follows:

1. Schedule A of the by-law is amended to include the following:

Parking By-law


For the purpose of section 2.1 of this By-law:

- a. The Parking By-law 2022-49 is a Designated By-law;
 - b. The penalties for a contravention of the Parking By-law 2022-49 are set out in Schedule 3 of the Parking By-law.
2. By adding the following Section 6.1(e):
6.1 (e): where a Penalty Notice is issued pursuant to By-law 2022-49, as amended by By-law 2022-49 or By-law 2001-88, as amended, service under this section shall be deemed effective upon the affixing of the Penalty Notice to a motor vehicle in a conspicuous manner.
 3. Section 10.2 of the by-law is amended by adding the following sub-sections:
(c) where the **Person** took all reasonable steps to prevent or avoid the contravention.
(d) where the **Screening Officer** deems it in the interest of justice to do so.
 4. Section 10.3 of the by-law is amended by adding the following sub-sections:
(c) where the **Person** took all reasonable steps to prevent or avoid the contravention.
(d) where the **Hearing Officer** deems it in the interest of justice to do so.

And Further that this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the enactment thereof.
