

As part of the on-going Lora Bay Boulder Channel Drainage Improvement project, the remaining culvert sections crossing West Ridge Drive will be installed the week of September 9th (schedule subject to change dependent on weather).

West Ridge Drive will remain open for the duration of the work but will be reduced to a single lane. Traffic control personnel and signage will be present during working hours to direct traffic. Please take notice of and comply with construction signage and all directions given by traffic control personnel. After working hours, jersey barriers will be placed surrounding any excavation, and temporary traffic signs including flashing lights will be in place when there is a lane closure.

During working hours there will be power outages. Affected customers will be notified by Hydro One regarding the exact timing and duration of the outages.

The work will be taking place near the cart path on the 18th Hole adjacent to West Ridge Drive. Golfers and pedestrians using the cart path should be advised of the work and use caution when approaching the work area.
