What is being proposed?

The Blue Mountains Council will be holding a Public Meeting to provide information to the public and to allow the public the opportunity to review and comment on the proposed amendments to the Fees and Charges By-law 2022-14 associated with applications under the Planning Act and other related planning applications, engineering technical review, works fees, and other related engineering matters.,

The Public Meeting will also provide information to the public and allow the public the opportunity to review and comment on the proposed amendments to By-law 2014-18 for Building Services Fees in accordance with Section 7 of the Building Code Act.

A presentation will be provided by the Town and Watson and Associates with details on the proposed Fees and Charges amendments.
