

The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains

By-Law Number 2025 – 74

Being a By-law to permanently close Railway Street Road Allowance

Whereas sections 9, 11 and 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the "Act"), enable a municipality to pass by-laws permanently closing highways;

Whereas Council has deemed it to be in the public interest to permanently close municipal highway known as Railway Street Road Allowance (PIN 37309-0370);

Whereas Council did adopt, in accordance with Section 270 of the Act, Policy POL.COR.07.03 (the "Policy") to prescribe the form and manner for the giving of public notice of its intention to consider this by-law;

Whereas public notice of the intention to enact this by-law has been given in accordance with the requirements of the Policy;

And Whereas Council considered staff report PBS.25.091 "Recommendation Report – Request to Purchase Portion of Railway Street" at the November 18, 2025 Committee of the Whole Meeting, and at the December 1, 2025 Council Meeting, directed that the within Bylaw be enacted;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains hereby enacts as follows:

The following portions of the Railway Road Allowance are hereby closed:


1. Railway St PI 811 Collingwood; The Blue Mountains (PIN 37309-0370)
2. Blk B PI 811 Collingwood; The Blue Mountains (PIN 37309-0366)

This By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the receipt of all required payments and registration of an executed and certified copy of this By-law in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Grey (#16).
