

Stationary Waste Box Placement Process



The following information outlines the requirements for the use and placement of a Stationary Waste Box within the Town road allowance for waste collection.

It is the property owner's responsibility to ensure the waste box is properly located at the curbside so that it is clearly visible, easily accessible for collection, and does not interfere with Town road maintenance activities such as snow clearing or ditch maintenance. The **Stationary Waste Box** can be purchased at many hardware stores.

The Stationary Waste Box:

- Shall be placed level, on either side of the laneway, approximately 1 metre (3 feet) from the laneway, and on the private side of the property boundary (not on the road).
- Shall not obscure or obstruct the sight lines of vehicles entering or exiting the laneway and shall not be located within any portion of the road ditch or on the shoulder of the road.
- The owner is responsible for ensuring the Stationary Waste Box remains level and free from snow, vegetation, shrubs, and other obstructions at all times.
- The owner is responsible for all maintenance and repairs to keep the Stationary Waste Box in good condition.
- Stationary waste boxes that are heavily snow-covered or buried, with excessively heavy lids, will not be serviced.

Indicator tabs, used to alert the collection company as to whether the Stationary Waste Box is full or empty, must be properly installed and clearly visible from the road for collection staff. Indicator tabs may be purchased at Town Hall, 32 Mill Street, Thornbury, or at the Landfill Site, 788090 Grey Road 13, Clarksburg.
