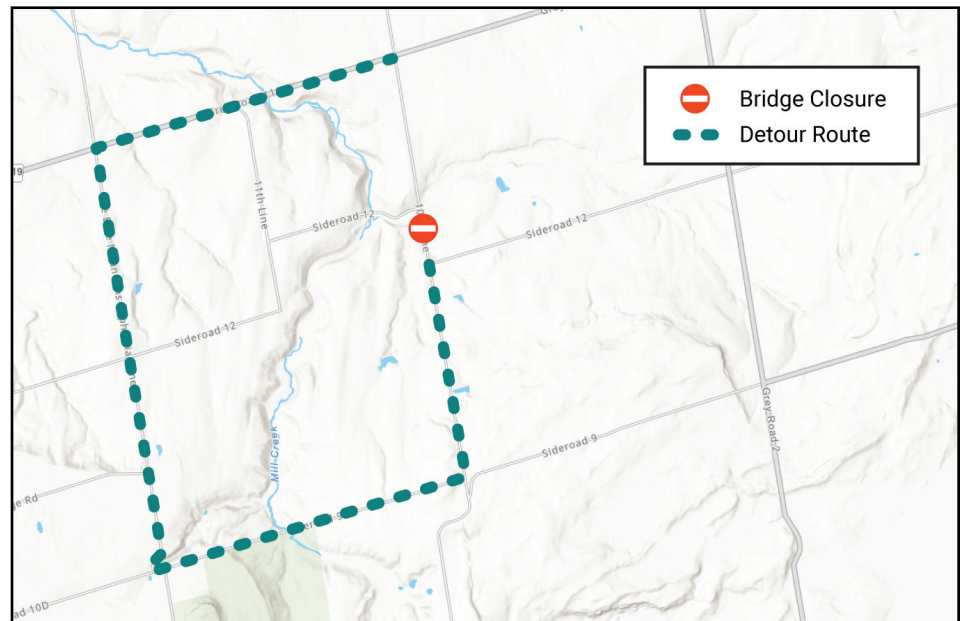
Start Date: June 25, 2026 (est.)

On behalf of the Town of The Blue Mountains, Elements Engineering Inc. has completed the design and engineering for rehabilitation works on the 10th Line Red Wing Bridge (Bridge 7).

The project has been tendered and the construction contract has been awarded to Arnott Construction Limited. Construction is expected to occur between June 25, 2026 and July 23, 2026.

Project Scope

- Concrete repairs to abutment, wingwalls, soffit and footings
- Building up wingwall
- Installation of new curb and asphalt shoulder
- Installation of bicycle railing

What To Expect

You may experience dust, noise, vibrations and other inconveniences as a result of construction. The Town will work with the contractor to reduce these impacts where possible by maintaining standard working hours and providing written notice of planned service interruptions or restrictions. We appreciate your patience throughout the project.

Works will be occurring within Town property. Should you have any concerns during construction, please contact the Site Inspector.

Work Hours

Work will generally take place Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Work after hours and on weekend will be completed only if necessary and as required. The contractor will be required to request approval from Town Council prior to completing any work outside of regular hours.

Road Access

In order to complete the work in a safe manner, 10th Line will be closed to all vehicular and pedestrian traffic between 12th Sideroad and 415860 10th Line for the duration of the construction period. Emergency services have been notified of the construction timeframe and the primary detour route.

Traffic Management

A complete road closure will be in effect during the construction period. 10th Line will be closed to all traffic between 12th Sideroad and 415860 10th Line. Local access to driveways and field accesses will be permitted, but there will be no access across the bridge. A primary detour route has been designated utilizing 10th Line, Sideroad 9, The Blue Mountains-Euphrasia Townline and Grey Road 119. This detour route will be indicated by signage.

Garbage and Recycling

Please follow your normal routine for garbage and recycling collection. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure your bins are labelled with your address.

Restoration

The construction work area will be restored to pre-existing or better conditions including laying of sod/hydroseed and placement of granular as required.
