Purpose of this Public Meeting

The purpose of this Public Meeting is to receive comments from the Public regarding the proposed new telecommunications tower.

For towers with a height of 15 meters or over the ISED and the Town's Protocol for Establishing Telecommunication Facilities require public consultation.

Project Details

- This tower will support critical municipal services, including:
 - Fire Services: Dispatch radio communications integrated with fire hall PA system.
 - IT & Network Infrastructure: Reliable primary and backup connections to key facilities and the Town's wide area network.
 - Water Services: Neptune AMI collector providing metering coverage to nearby developments.
 - Tower Height and Type: 80ft freestanding, lattice style – no lighting.
 - Tower Location: North-East corner of fire hall property set back from Grey Road 19 roughly 150 meters.

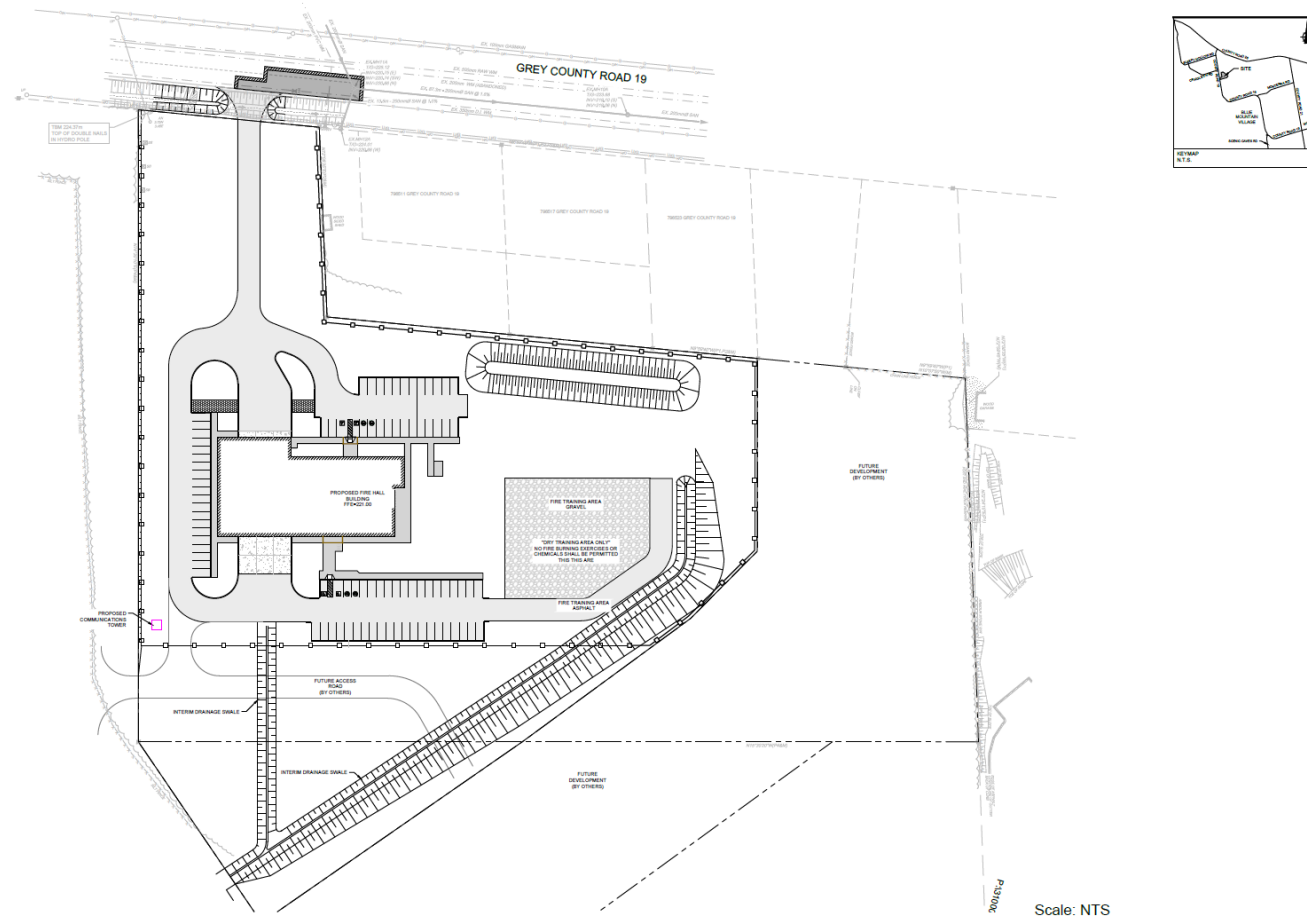

RF Antenna - 2-Way Radio System

- Enables dispatch announcements at Fire Hall 2 and ensures reliable communication with Barrie Dispatch.
- Serves as the fire halls connection to the Town's new Fire/Roads simulcast radio system.

Point to Point Infrastructure

- Internet access and network access to the Town's files and applications.

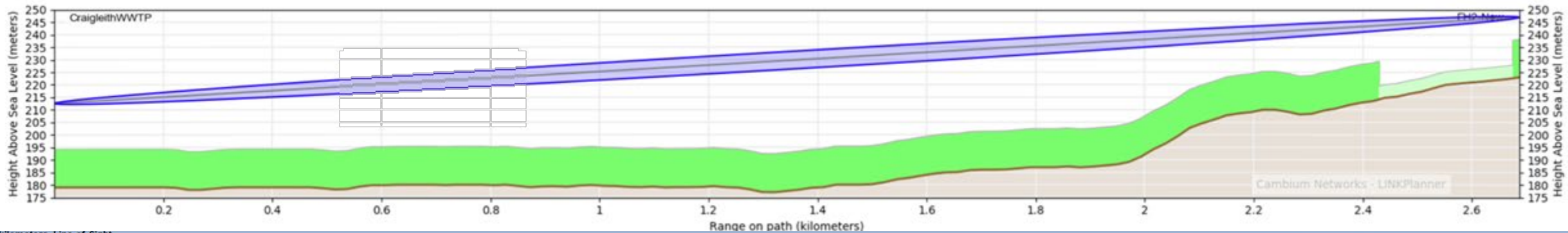
Connections to:

- Happy Valley Booster – Booster Station backup.

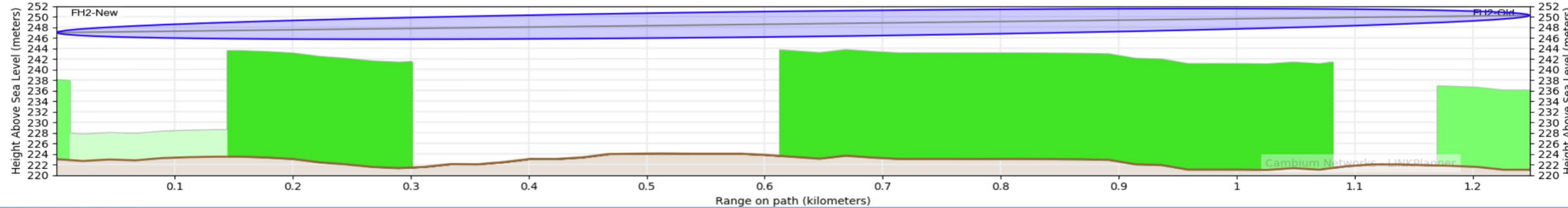


Point to Point Link Profiles

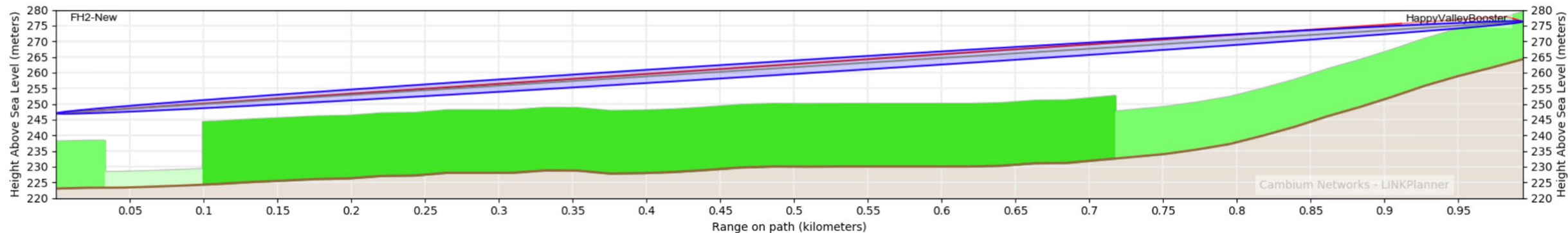
Profile: 2.687 kilometers, Line-of-Sight



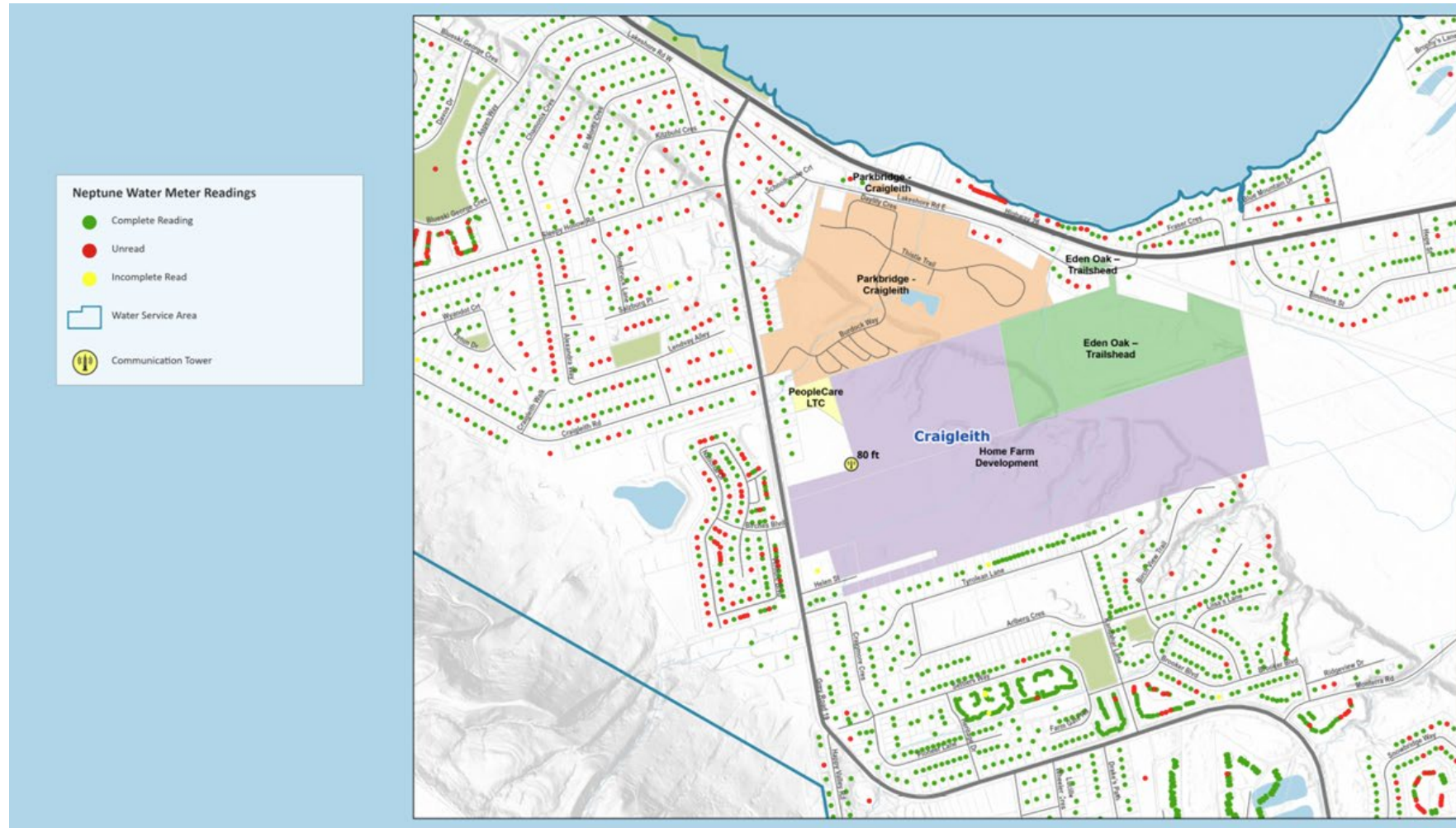
Profile: 1.248 kilometers, Line-of-Sight
